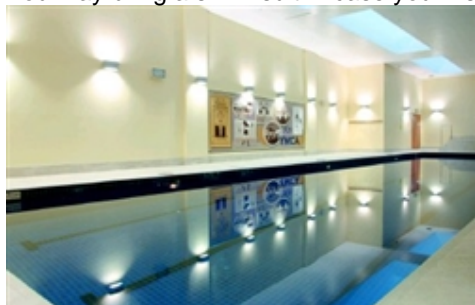
WHAT TO BRING

You **MUST** bring your **Student ID card**, as mentioned above.
